



ABOUT THE UNIROYAL® GIANT TIRE RENOVATION

Beginning in August 2003, the Giant Tire will undergo a major renovation. The tire's main structure will be repaired and the exterior will be updated. Various structural improvements will also be made to ensure the longevity of the tire. Below are the changes that will be made to the Giant Tire during the renovation.

- The inside structure of the tire will be sandblasted to remove the original paint.
- More than 30 steel beams inside the tire will be replaced and painted.
- The base of the tire will be rebuilt and repainted.
- New asphalt and storm drains will be installed.
- The Uniroyal® website address (uniroyal.com) will be added in reflective lettering.
- The hubcap of the tire will be repainted in silver.
- The neon lighting that was added in 1994 will be replaced with reflective lettering to illuminate "Uniroyal."
- New lighting, fencing and landscaping will be added to the surrounding areas.

SOME FUN FACTS ABOUT THE UNIROYAL GIANT TIRE

- It would take 960 Uniroyal passenger tires to make the Uniroyal Giant Tire.
- If the Uniroyal Giant Tire was an actual tire on a car, at 80 feet it would fit on a 200-foot-tall car.
- A Uniroyal passenger tire is typically 25 inches tall and weighs 25 pounds – compared to the Uniroyal Giant Tire which is 80 feet tall and weighs 12 tons.
